Reported illnesses have ranged from mild symptoms to severe illness and death for confirmed coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) cases.

The following symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure:

- Fever
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Shortness of breath
- Nausea/Vomiting
- Diarrhea

Emergency Warning Signs Include:

- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Persistent pain or pressure on the chest
- New confusion or inability to arouse
- Bluish lips or face

If you have a temperature of 100.0 or greater, any of the below symptoms, have traveled to an international area with sustained (ongoing) transmission within the last 14 days, or have been exposed to COVID-19 in the last 10 days, you will not be allowed into the facility.
